- **ἀγρυπνέω** – to be sleepless, wakeful, keep watch, be on alert for the congregations' souls: Heb. 13:17
- **λαλέω** - to speak the Word of God: Heb. 13:7
- **ἀναστροφή** - spiritual conduct of life: Heb. 13:7
- **τύπος** – be an example in speech, conduct, love, faith, and purity: 1Tim. 4:12
- **παραγγέλλω**– to instruct: 1Tim. 1:3
- **κῆρυξ** – a herald for the King of Kings: 1Tim. 2:7
- **διακονία** – serving the local church: 1Cor. 12:5
- **διδάσκαλος** – teachers: 1Cor. 12:28;
- **διδακτικός** – able to teach: 1Tim. 3:2
- **διδάσκω** – to teach: 1Tim. 4:11
- **ποιμαίνω** – to shepherd: 1Pt. 5:2
- **ἐπισκοπέω** – to look upon; to take care of; to oversee; to exercise authority: 1Pt. 5:2
- **ὑποτίθημι** – to lay down; make known; to teach: 1Tim. 4:6
- **ἀνάγνωσις** – public exhortation of doctrine: 1Tim.4:13
- **παράκλησις** – encouragement; comfort; exhort: 1Tim. 4:13
- **μελετάω** - Meditate on; bestow thought on; to cultivate; constantly take pains with doctrine: 1Tim. 4:15
- **εἶμι ἐν οὗτοις** – be in them (doctrine); be engrossed in doctrine: 1Tim. 4:15
- **ἐπέχω** – hold fast to doctrine: 1Tim. 4:16
- **ἐπιμένω** – stay on; continue; remain in doctrine: 1Tim. 4:16
- **προΐστημι** – to rule: 1Tim. 5:17
- **κοπιάω** – labor and toil and the Word and Doctrine: 1Tim. 5:17
- **φυλάσσω** – guard the doctrine in his soul: 1Tim. 6:20
- **ὑπομινῆσκω** – remind believers of doctrine: 2Tim. 2:14
- **σπουδάζω** – be diligent in studying, teaching, and applying doctrine: 2Tim. 2:15
- **πιστόω** – be convinced and firmly believe in doctrine: 2Tim. 3:14
- **ἐλέγχο ἐπιτιμάω παρακαλέω** – reprove, rebuke, exhort the congregation with doctrine: 2Tim. 4:2
- **ἀντέχω** – hold fast the faithful Word: Tit. 1:9
- **ἐπιστομίζω** – silence those upsetting the congregation: Tit. 1:11
- **παραιτέομαι** – reject heretics: Tit. 3:10
